Water Quality Information

August 29, 2016

Dear Stafford Families,

This letter is being sent to update you about the water quality testing results that were shared last week. The initial results from July testing at Stafford Primary School showed that out of 76 test locations, three indicated elevated levels of lead that exceeded the action level of 20 parts per billion. This included two sink faucets in the kitchen and one sink faucet in a classroom.

Immediate remediation steps were taken include turning water off at these locations, replacing subject fixtures, and retesting. After remediation, water was retested on August 19. The three fixtures tested below the action level of 20 ppb. These results have cleared all fixtures at Stafford Primary School for elevated levels of lead or copper.
