Water Quality Information

August 25, 2016

Dear Rosemont Ridge Families,

This letter is being sent to update you about the water quality testing results that were shared on July 25, 2016. The initial results from July testing at Rosemont Ridge Middle School showed that out of 110 test locations, three indicated elevated levels of lead that exceeded the action level of 20 parts per billion. This included two science classroom lab sink faucets and one sink faucet in a restroom in the boys' locker room.

Immediate remediation steps were taken include turning water off at these locations, replacing subject fixtures, and retesting. After remediation, water was retested on August 16. All fixtures tested below the action level of 20 ppb. These results have cleared all fixtures at Rosemont Ridge Middle School for elevated levels of lead or copper.
