Water Quality Information

September 2, 2016

Dear Wilsonville High School Families,

This letter is being sent to update you about the water quality testing results that were shared on August 29. The initial results from testing at Wilsonville High School showed that out of 203 test locations, two indicated elevated levels of lead that exceeded the action level of 20 parts per billion and two indicated elevated levels of copper that exceeded the action level of 1,350 parts per billion. The elevated levels of lead were in a sink faucet in a kitchen area and in a sink faucet in a shower room. The elevated levels of copper were in two lab sinks in classrooms.

Immediate remediation steps were taken include turning water off at these locations, replacing subject fixtures, and retesting. After remediation, water was retested. The fixtures tested below the action levels for lead and copper. These results have cleared all fixtures at Wilsonville High School for elevated levels of lead or copper.
