
The redesigned ODE school report card provides additional information. Art Tech's Overall State Rating of 1 indicates improvements are to be made for reading and math and that we

Art Tech is building a strong community. We look forward to collaborating with you to grow the greatest thinkers and most thoughtful people for the world.




