
The redesigned ODE school report card provides additional information. West Linn's Overall State Rating of 5 indicates we meet targets for reading and math. West Linn is proud of our

West Linn thrives in a strong community. We look forward to collaborating with you to grow the greatest thinkers and most thoughtful people for the world.




Level 2 = Falls between 5% and 15% of schools
