
The redesigned ODE school report card provides additional information. Wilsonville's Overall State Rating of 4 indicates we meet targets for reading and math. However, as long as there is a



The overall state rating is intended to summarize this school's particular successes and challenges. It is based on a combination of up to five factors. Three of these factors come from standardized test scores in reading and math: student achievement, student growth, and the growth of underserved subgroups. Level 1 = Falls into the bottom 5% of schools


Level 2 = Falls between 5% and 15% of schools
